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**41. Three Choirs – Classic Cuvée, Brut – 12%**

A well respected sparkling from the vineyard only a few miles away at Newent

Jeio Rose is made by the Prosecco House Bisol, who have used their expertise to produce a wonderfully gentle pink fizz, full of summer fruits and just a hint of spice

From Piedmont in North West Italy, local grape variety Brachetto d'Acqui. It is a slightly sweet sparkling with an abundance of strawberry and raspberry fruit

Pol Roger's signature cuvée, displaying all the characteristics of the house: fresh, pure fruit and very fine bubbles

### **1. La Maison Belenger, Cotes De Gascogne - 11%**

Light and clean with Floral and Citrus notes

### **2. Spy Valley Marlborough, Sauvignon Blanc - 13.5%**

Classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, the gooseberry and lime fruit nose leads to a palate of fresh passion and citrus fruits..

### **3. Little Eden Moscato, Australia - 5.5%**

Refreshing white peach and elements of mineral/savoury influences. Layers of fruit unfold over a long, focussed palate. Spectator magazine declared it to be one of the planets 20 most notable new producers and famed for its Sauvignon Blanc.

Very different from The Charles Smith wine, Classic dry Riesling from Germany, with a subtle power and intensity



### **33. Gnarly Head Pinot Noir – California - 13.5%**

Aromas of mocha, vanilla and oak with notes of black cherry, spice, fruity medium body

### **34. Dinastia Vivanco Rioja Reserva – 14%**

A fine example of Rioja, beautifully made using only the best fruit the estate has to offer

### **35. Charles Smith Boom Boom Syrah, USA - 13.5%**

Aromas of fresh picked herbs and wet earth. Rich black cherry and tobacco are followed by hints of lavender on the finish. An explosive dark cherry bomb!

### **36. Journeys End - The Pastors Blend, Stellenbosch South Africa - 13.5%**

Dark plum fruit with a real earthiness and hint of sweet spice.  
The fruit is juicy and the wine has some herbaceous, minty notes with a soft velvety finish.

### **37. Chateau Coucheroy, 2008 - 12.5%**

Pessac-Leognan produces wonderfully precise and structured wines, drinking at its best right now!

### **38. Fratelli Barba Vignafra, Montepulciano d'Abruzzo -13.5%**

The Italian wine guide, The Gambero Rosso, loves this winery and this wine in particular!

### **39. Battle of Bosworth Puritan Shiraz, McLaren Vale – 14.5%**

Organically grown & certified with no preservatives producing a fresh style of shiraz

### **40. De Trafford, Blueprint Syrah, Stellenbosch, 2011 – 15.5%**

Quite aromatic with dark cherry and plum fruit complimented with white pepper, floral, nutty and herbal notes. Full, elegant, complex fruit and soft ripe tannins

### **36. Paolo Conterno Barolo 2010 Italy -14.5%**

A big bold wine with aromas and flavours of plums, ripe red cherry and liquorice; smooth and well-balanced..

### **37. Envoy Outpost Pinot Noir 2011 -13.5%**

A deep garnet colour with delicate cherry and spice notes red berry fruits and a stunning wine with firm tannin.

### **38. Morgan Cotes du Crow's Syrah Grenache Santa Lucia Highlands, USA, 2009 - 13.5%**

Ripe blackberry and vanilla tinged Syrah fruit with classic strawberry/rhubarb Grenache notes on the nose and palate. Medium bodied but with plenty of punchy fruit flavours
